



Let's explore *Little Village - Detroit* *Pewabic Pottery*



Little Village is a 3.5-acre, arts-focused cultural corridor on Detroit's east side, featuring The Shepherd, a converted church, "It Takes A Village" skatepark designed by Tony Hawk and The LANTERN arts hub.

Pewabic Pottery was founded in 1903. The studio is known for its iridescent glazes, some of which grace notable buildings such as the Shedd Aquarium and Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception.
